On its own motion, the Court hereby orders that the People's Opposition to the Defense's Motion to Disinter Sandra Cantu's Body is sealed, pursuant to California Rule of Court 2.550.


The Court makes the following findings:

Ensuring a fair trial to both sides in this case and the privacy rights of the Cantu family constitute overriding interests that overcome the right of public access to this pleading. The overriding interests support the

1 sealing of this pleading. A substantial probability exists that the  
2 overriding interests will be prejudiced if the pleading is not sealed. The  
3 sealing of this pleading is narrowly tailored. The detailed information  
4 contained within the pleading and its attachments are inextricably  
5 intertwined with prejudicial information. There are no less restrictive  
6 means by which to accomplish the overriding interests.

7 For the foregoing reasons, the pleading entitled "People's Opposition to  
8 the Defense Motion to Disinter Sandra Cantu's Body" is hereby sealed.
